Reflection

He sees people bartering over mere pennies, animals being bought for sacrifice, and people milling about in a space designated for prayer and worship. This all seems foreign to us, as our churches do not resemble this chaotic scene. Or do they? Are we good stewards of our space? Jesus was angered at the lack of reverence in His Father's house. Do we struggle with this in our own church?

Jesus wanted the temple to be a place of worship for ALL people, yet there were divisions that segregated particular groups to particular areas. Is there anything about your parish that keeps the seeking stranger from finding God? Is it a welcoming place? Are YOU welcoming?
